## The 3<sup>rd</sup> Year Program

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Thank you for your interest in the Third-Year Ministerial program of Faith Landmarks Bible Institute!

This program is specifically designed for those who sense the call of God on their lives to the five-fold ministry or to the full-time ministry of helps. Our desire is to provide preparatory training and instruction that will equip the individual for full time ministry and the fulfillment of God's call on their life. (See note on ordination below)

The fall trimester will focus on classroom instruction in key areas of ministry: Ministerial Preparation (General Session), Evangelism, Helps Ministry, Missions, and the Church Track. The winter trimester will include some classroom instruction by guest speakers and **the planning and preparation of a ministry project**, which each student must complete to graduate from the program. These projects would entail such things as church planting, a local evangelistic outreach, a small group Bible study, or an overseas crusade, depending on the student's area of interest. It is up to each student to seek the Lord for direction, then plan, fund, and execute their project. The spring trimester is the time for these projects to take place.

The prerequisites for this program are:

1. The applicant must be a second-year graduate of FLBI or a similar institution that is accepted by FLBI. (Transcript required.)
2. The applicant must be willing and able to attend full time, throughout the entire school year. (No applicants will be accepted in the winter or spring trimesters.)
3. The applicant, through an essay, must communicate evidence of the call of God on their lives and His vision for their future.

To apply for this program, please fill out the attached application completely. Incomplete applications may not be considered. Be sure to include your photo and your essay. If you are not a member of FLM, a pastoral reference form (found in this package) should be given to your Pastor for completion and returned to us.

**Your application for admission must be submitted to the Registrar or the church office by Sunday, September 2, 2018. You will be notified of your acceptance by September 7<sup>th</sup>. Orientation and class begins on Sunday, September 9<sup>th</sup>. The majority of communication to you, now and throughout the school year, will be by e-mail. If you do not have an e-mail address, we encourage you to get one by September 7<sup>th</sup>!**

**(Ordination:** We believe that ordination is man's recognition of God's ministry call on one's life. Ordination is available once someone becomes a member of Faith Landmarks Ministerial Fellowship, and it is not dependent on attendance or completion of FLBI courses.
